MEDALS PROGRAM AWARDS

Outstanding Students

Three male and three female students from the senior class are nominated by Upper Dublin High School faculty who have displayed outstanding leadership qualities in the classroom (academics) and involvement in athletics, music, drama or other school and community activities. The Selection Committee chooses one male and one female to receive the award which includes a \$1,000 scholarship.

Outstanding Educator

The award is presented to an educator who has made a significant contribution to the educational process. The individual should possess the ability to inspire students and raise educational achievement; should be truly dedicated and possess a high degree of expertise in his/her chosen field; demonstrate a willingness to share ideas, talents, and experience; and participate in both school and community activities. This award is limited to either a full-time administrator or teacher employed by the Upper Dublin School District.

Outstanding Citizen

This award is given to a resident of Upper Dublin in recognition of exemplary service to the community including charitable work, volunteer service, long-term community involvement or other special achievements that benefited the entire Upper Dublin community. (Excludes those currently serving in elected/appointed positions.)

Outstanding Business/Non-Profit

The Selection Committee recognizes one community non-profit organization or business that has contributed significantly to enhancing the opportunities for Upper Dublin students and/or
